



#### **Contract Continuation Sheet**

- 1. In motion system and HD system(stationary) to be in the coach 2 HD receivers, 2 low def receivers elimating having to change satellite in the settings menu. Both systems to be connected to front and bedroom
- 2. Dinette sleeper. Install table leg so it doesn't have to be removed for floor drop.-leg to be on same part of slide that dinette seats are. Dup 1412 the dinette should have inserts like 1412 and include a 2 piece mattress for ease of carrying- 4" base with 3" memory foam approx 72" long
- 3. Floor to be light weight travertine (same as Roos) at entry way driver and all through front of coach to bedroom, using black coins instead of Copper like in Roos Coach all of this travertine to be heated including drivers area also floor to include 2" ribbon like Roos 1455. Coins to be every 4 squares
  - 4. Bedroom to be sculpted carpet, rear bath to be black heated marble
- 5. In bay number two A/B switch and coax termination near 110 power outlet. tv A (front) tv B (rear Tv). Coax and A/B switch only
- 6. Three switches at 3 locations to power on/off a/v components of all TV's. Switches to be located at 1. Aft of dinette 2. forward wall at head of bed 3. Rear wall at head of bed. Salon A/V and TV to have 4th master switch located at dash. If more TV's added make power switches to these tv's in these locations
  - 7. Add old style eckornes chair with separate footstool(consul model)
  - 8. Add Train Horn with foot control at left of driver
- 9. Add Music Horn PMMI above silverleaf in overhead if possible if not somewhere on dash is fine to be removed from old coach
  - 10. Fabric for couch to be same as 1454. This couch will jacknife
- 11. Add switch by valid level system for door open/close and for step cover extend/retract
  - 12. Large shower to have foot rest under shower valve
- 13. Rear bath and 1/2 bath to have window with clear glass- not frosted both windows vented
- 14. Window to be located above toilet in rear bath (like 1447) Corian shelf to be built just under window to hide accent lighting. Accent lighting to be

in the same locations in rear bath as in 1447.

- 15. Pantry with adj shelves in area between #1 and #2 slide
- 16. 2 fanatastik fans, 1 in half bath 1 in rear bath.
- 17. Upper cabinet in #3 slide to have a 26" LED TV angled on a hinge-up door similar to front overhead cabinet with storage behind. Overhead cabinet in #2 room to be similar to the standard #3 room Audio/Video cabinet
  - 18. No subwofer in front or rear
  - 19. Add verticle assist bar in half bath
- 20. Add Book Cases in Bedroom like 1454 with velcro access panels to Valid slides
  - 21. Bed to be 72 x 80
  - 22. add 2 drawers each side of bed, no closet aft end of #3 slide
  - 23. Adjustable shelves in #2 room closets
  - 24. #4 slide to duplicate 1454 extcept dinette which duplicates 1412
  - 25. Cooktop in #1 slide to be 2 burner recessed with hinge corian top
  - 26. Add mitchell wind deflector at drivers window
  - 27. Add mitchell Chrome petals
  - 28. Rosen Radio-Add
  - 29. Front entry door with outside locks & thumb strikers to be installed
  - 30. Add shut of valve to air chuck for tow vehicle
  - 31. Add subzero bev cooler at galley with overlay door # UC-24BG-O
  - 32. Subzero 700 to be stainless without ice maker (special model 700TC)
- 33. In area of beverage cooler, preplumb for dishwasher so that next owner can easily install dishwaher
  - 34. Where coffee maker is on 1454, make paper towell holder with door

- 36. Duplicate trash can compartment in 1454- This will allow for trash and recycle container
  - 37. Add Switch at dash to run either front or bedroom A/C
- 38. Add VMS 440CL -silverleaf programing to have 6 gagues on upper driver panel instead of the 3 that are currently available
  - 39. No video to appear on either silverleaf drivers panels
- 40. Install C/F solar panel controls recessed in wall with panel door, C/F circuit breaker (no circuit breakers but big fuses at batteries) Newell to run 8 ga.(shielded wire) from batteries to controls and on to 10' stub out **on roof.**
- 41. Temp sensor above drivers head area to be located in the front cap above windshield in the center like 1214- Dave Parkman
  - 42. Drivers seat to have lap belt only
- 43. VGA cable to be run from the front overhead to above driver to the desk area in the #1 slide

50. three 10.4" LCD monitors to be located at 1. forward side of #4 slide 2. drivers rear camera 3. At passenger's dash. All of these monitors to have 4/way switches. A 4th monitor will be the 26" tv in the bedroom also to be used as a four way monitor with input change from bed. Other 3 monitors to have camera buttons to change imput. UNLESS OTHERWISE AGREED IN WRITING, NEWELL COACH CORPORATION MAKES NO REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH STATE AND LOCAL MOTOR VEHICLE CODES, REGULATIONS AND STATUTES, NOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE CODES, REGULATIONS, AND STATUTES OF COUNTRIES OTHER THAN THE UNITED STATES.

### **Additional Terms Of Purchase**

- 1. Newell Coach Corp. ("Newell") agrees to sell and Purchaser agrees to buy for the price set forth in this Agreement the motor coach described herein, subject to the terms and conditions of the Coach Order ("Order"). Point of Purchase and Delivery: The offices of Newell, North Highway 69, Commerce, Oklahoma.
- 2. Newell follows a policy of continual product improvement and refinement. As a result, changes to standard equipment and features, specifications, and optional equipment may occur at any time. In addition, certain changes, including those described in the prior sentence, may be made as a result of events and occurrences beyond the control of Newell.
- 3. The Purchaser agrees to promptly provide Newell with any additional information and decisions as may be necessary to complete this Order. In the event that the Purchaser fails to notify Newell of additional information or decisions, and a delay in completing this Order could result, the Purchaser authorizes Newell to exercise Newell's best judgment in determining how to proceed so as not to delay completion of this Order.
- 4. Purchaser agrees to deliver to Newell negotiable title to any property traded in as a part of the consideration for the coach ordered hereunder at the time of delivery of such trade-in property to Newell. Purchaser warrants any such property to be his/her property, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as otherwise disclosed and noted herein. SELLER FURTHER WARRANTS THAT THE TITLE FOR ANY SUCH TRADE-IN PROPERTY IS "CLEAR," AND CONTAINS NO WARNINGS OR NOTIFICATIONS SUCH AS "SALVAGE," "REBUILT," "JUNK," OR "REMANUFACTURED" UNLESS SUCH NOTIFICATION HAS BEEN DISCLOSED TO NEWELL IN WRITING AND ACCEPTED BY NEWELL IN WRITING PRIOR TO THE EXECUTION OF THIS CONTRACT. SHOULD PURCHASER BREACH THIS PROVISION, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED BY NEWELL AND PURCHASER THAT THE TRADE-IN ALLOWANCE SHALL BE REDUCED BY FIFTY (50) PERCENT UNLESS OTHERWISE MUTUALLY AGREED.
- 5. Newell shall not be liable for failure to deliver or delay in delivering the coach covered by this Order where such failure or delay is due, in whole or in part, to any cause beyond the control of Newell.
- 6. The price for the coach specified on the face of this Order does not include sales taxes, use taxes, or license fees. Purchaser agrees to assume sole responsibility for the full and proper payment of any and all such taxes and fees.
- 7. NEWELL DISCLAIMS ALL EXPRESS AND IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING THOSE OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE AND MERCHANTABILITY. NEWELL SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR, AND NEITHER PURCHASER NOR ANY DIRECT OR REMOTE TRANSFEREE OF PURCHASER SHALL HAVE ANY RIGHT TO RECOVER FROM NEWELL, ANY CONSEQUENTIAL OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF USE, LOSS OF TIME, LOSS OF PROFITS OR INCOME, INCONVENIENCE, OR ANY OTHER DAMAGES, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH DAMAGES ARE CHARACTERIZED AS "CONSEQUENTIAL," "INCIDENTAL," "COMPENSATORY," OR OTHERWISE.
- 8. Unless specifically agreed in writing to the contrary, Newell is under no obligation to extend or



PURCHASER AND NEWELL AGREE THAT SUCH AMOUNT IS A REASONABLE AMOUNT FOR LIQUIDATED DAMAGES, AND THAT IT WOULD BE IMPRACTICAL, EXTREMELY DIFFICULT, OR IMPOSSIBLE TO FIX THE ACTUAL DAMAGES.
- 10. From time to time prior to completion of this Order and delivery of the coach, changes to the specifications or pricing may be made by mutual agreement of the Purchaser and Newell. Newell will document such changes by written Change Orders with a copy furnished to the Purchaser. - 11. Concurrent with delivery of the coach ordered hereunder, Newell will issue a final invoice to the Purchaser. Such invoice may reflect adjustments to the new coach price, or if a trade-in is a portion of the consideration, the difference price, made by mutual agreement of Newell and the Purchaser. Payment by the purchaser or his/her agent of the balance due as shown on such invoice shall indicate the agreement of the purchaser to the revised coach price as shown on such invoice. Further, if a trade-in is a portion of the consideration, the difference price shown on the invoice shall constitute the agreement between the Purchaser and Newell as to the amount thereof. THIS ORDER, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE PERFORMANCE OR CLAIMED LACK OF PERFORMANCE OF ANY DUTIES OWED BY ANY PARTY UNDER THIS ORDER, ANY CLAIMED DEFECT(S) IN THE COACH WHICH IS THE SUBJECT OF THIS ORDER AND/OR ANY SERVICES CONNECTED THEREWITH, SHALL BE IN THE DISTRICT COURT IN AND FOR OTTAWA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA. IN ANY SUCHLAWSUIT, THE PARTIES AGREE THAT THE PREVAILING PARTY SHALL RECEIVE, IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER DAMAGES WHICH SUCH PARTY MAY BE AWARDED, AN AWARD OF THE ATTORNEYS' FEES, COSTS AND LITIGATION EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE PREVAILING PARTY IN SUCH LAWSUIT.

- 13. Separability. If any provision of this Order is rendered or declared illegal or unenforceable, all other provisions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 14. The Purchaser further certifies that he/she is of legal age and hereby acknowledges receipt of a copy of this Order.
